

PARKAS' project period extended to 2022!

The Research Council has approved an extension of the project period from November 2021 to June 2022

The research group, with collaborative partners, is now finalising the interview process and data analysis. We have initiated the production of research papers and reports based on the results from the data collected over 3 years in Hardangervidda National Park and Saltfjellet-Svartisen National Park (including the surrounding villages and landscape conservation areas). Some papers are either published (or soon will be).

The feedbacks from the people collected during the local Workshops in 2021, as well as the results from the discussions at the Mid-term Seminar in June 2021, are actively used in our current research and writings.

Next year we will organize an End Symposium with a complete presentation of our findings across PARKAS' main research topics.
